

Commonly referred to as the *short-tailed weasel*, in scientific terms these animals are known as *Mustela Erminea* and are members of the *Mustelidae* family.

Stoats have an elongated body with a small triangular head and a uniform, symmetrical body shape that allows them to follow prey into narrow burrows or tunnels. They typically have brown fur with a white bib and underbelly with a black tip on the very end of their tails. But during winter climates, stoats can grow a pure white coat.

These animals are flexible and adventurous predators. They usually live in woodlands, grasslands, and moorlands in cool and temperate regions.
