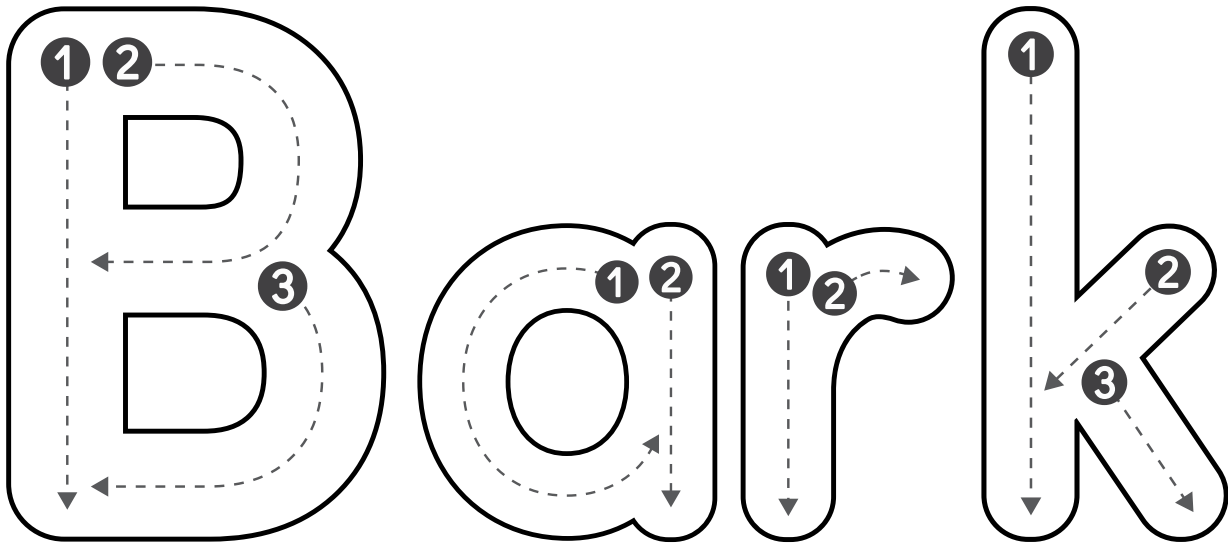

The word of the week is:

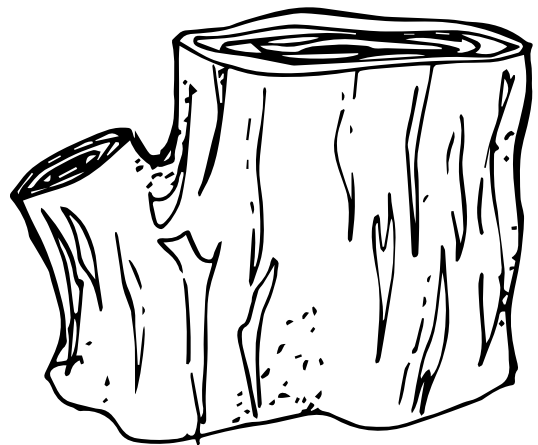


The outermost layer of stems and roots of wooden plants. Plants that have wood include trees, woody vines, and shrubs.

Bark in many ways, is similar to our human skin as it's essential for the trees survival.

The outer cork protects the tree from the elements and helps protect the tree from infection, insect attacks, and from the attention of hungry birds and mammals.

Bark looks different for each tree species, and has evolved to withstand the environment the species grows in.
