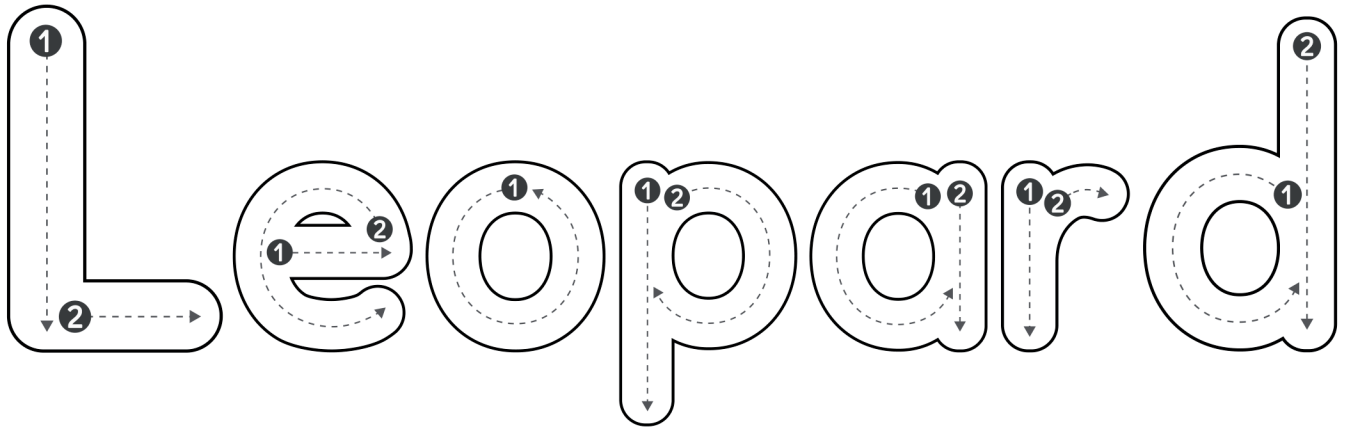

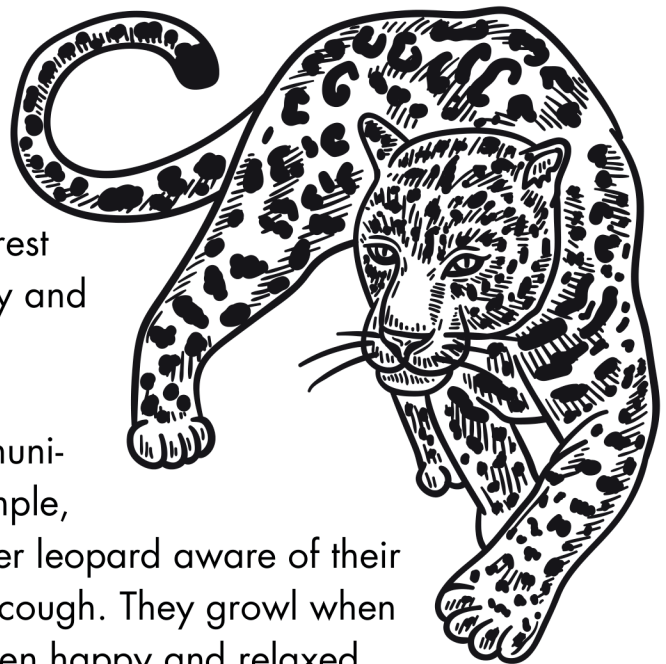
The word of the week is:
